Finance	Wally reported that as of this week our accounts are nearly out of the red.

Financial	Finance Committee is reviewing expenditures for technology, in hopes of achieving some

	Wally opened a discussion on whether to change our fiscal year to something like July-	
	June, which would take time to implement. Recommends putting constitution revision on	
	a future agenda.	
Pastor's Report	A national synod staff member who works remotely has asked to use an office at Faith.	
•	Shannyn sees an advantage for her in having a colleague in the office. Council reviewed a	
	draft Memorandum of Understanding and approved it once it was updated to state the	
	correct location. Final draft will be submitted to the executive committee by email for	
	their approval.	
	Faith has received a \$5,000 grant to create new content for our social media websites,	
	and for new platforms as well. This should create four months' worth of well-produced	
	content.	
New Business	Members raised the question of our committee structure and whether we wish to	
	officially disband some committees. This is deferred to a future meeting.
